<p>Preparations will be held at three centers: Heisler, Daysland and Killam. The preparation includes special catechism classes (from November 2010 to April 2011) and a retreat (in April 2011- the date will be announced at later time after consultation with the parents). The registration form can be downloaded at our website at www.rcfamily.ca or contact our parish office for a copy. The registration deadline is October 22, 2010. Please send the registration to the office by mail, fax or e-mail. The only reason that will be accepted for not attending a class is sickness.
