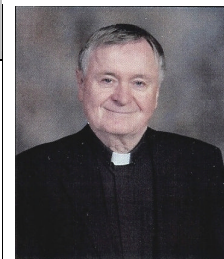

The Feast of the Holy Trinity

Today is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. Last weekend, the feast of Pentecost brought to a close the celebration of Easter. Today's feast, The Most Holy Trinity, helps us to reflect on the act of the Holy Trinity, God the Father, God the Son, God the Holy Spirit, in the work of Salvation which we celebrated over the fifty days of the Easter season. This feast day today recalls what we experienced during Easter time of the saving act by the one, only and true God, as the gospel of John says, "God so loved the world that he gave his only son, so that everyone who believes in him might have eternal life. For God did not send his son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world might be saved through him." We might add, Alleluia!

Today's feast of The Most Holy Trinity is a celebration of the mystery of God. However, it is ever more so, a declaration of the self-revelation of God in relationship to people and the whole of creation. God is the Father, creator and origin of all that exists. Out of love for humanity Jesus Christ, the son of the Father, the second person of the Most Holy Trinity, equal in Godhead and majesty with God the Father, was sent for the sinful, fallen world's salvation. The Father, with the Son, has sent the Holy Spirit, the third Person of the Most Holy Trinity, equal in Godhead and majesty with the Father and the Son, to be our Advocate. God the Holy Spirit, with his seven fold gifts, enables and empowers us to proclaim the truth of who God is and the sole savior, Jesus Christ.

Today we celebrate God, a trinity of persons, one eternal God. As God has revealed God's self as a trinity of persons, a community of persons, existing in eternal love one for the other Person, so we the Church, are formed as a community of persons, modeled after the very being of God, existing in love for God and for one another. The Church, as a community of persons, models the being of God best when we act in love as a community of love.
