The renewal of baptismal promises:

(First Communicants light their candles)

To emphasize the unity of the Sacraments of Initiation, those, who are to receive the Eucharist for the first time, as well as their parents and friends, and all the people in the church, will renew the promises of Baptism at this time. The questions are worded in a manner suitable to young children.

PRIEST: Do you believe in God, our creator, who called you into life & knows you by name and loves you?

ALL: I DO.

PRIEST: Do you believe in Jesus, who loves you and who died and rose to give you new life?

ALL: I DO.

PRIEST: Do you believe in the Holy Spirit, who lives in you and makes you holy?

ALL: I DO.

PRIEST: Do you want always to try to live the way your loving God wants you to live, by avoiding what is bad and trying to do what is good?

ALL: I DO.

PRIEST: Do you believe that we are all children of God, that we are all brothers and sisters and that God loves us all?

ALL: I DO.

PRIEST: Do you believe that God forgives us and calls us to forgive one another?

ALL: I DO.

PRIEST: Do you believe that because of Jesus we will live forever and ever?

ALL: I DO.

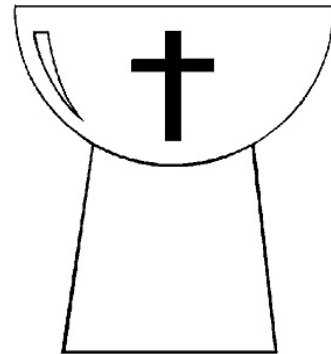
PRIEST: *This is our Faith. This is the Faith of the Church. We are proud to profess it, in Christ Jesus our Lord.*
